## PAUL L. KIMMELMAN

Paul L. Kimmelman is a senior advisor in education at American Institutes for Research. His work primarily involves federal education policy analysis and offering consultation on leadership, organizational capacity building, and innovation. He has authored three books on education and numerous articles, as well as given presentations on policy, building organizational capacity, leadership, and innovation. He has taught graduate level courses at several universities and was program coordinator for organizational leadership at Argosy University. He worked in K-12 education for 33 years as a teacher, assistant high school principal, middle school principal, assistant superintendent, and superintendent. He served as president of the First in the World Consortium, a group of 20 school districts that were the first to participate in the international Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study (TIMSS) research testing in a capacity other than as a country.
