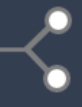

<a href="#">Creating Unit Plans</a>	Developing a unit plan can seem like an overwhelming task. But, we've outlined seven steps that you and your instructional team can follow to manage the process and to make sure that all your bases are covered. Includes a sample Unit Plan as well as a template.
<a href="#">Enhanced Lesson Design</a>	Document explains both whole class instruction and the personal competencies that may be added to any lesson plan in order to enhance the lesson. Includes a template for adding competencies to a lesson plan.
<a href="#">Units of Instruction</a>	The unit plan is developed by the Instructional Team to define a <b>unit of instruction</b> and outline the standards and target objectives (typically grade level) addressed in the unit of instruction. A unit of instruction is typically about four weeks of work within a subject area. Includes a template for planning instructional units and a template for aligning units to standards.
<a href="#">Weekly Class Schedule</a>	Includes a sample as well as a template for planning a whole week class schedule.
<a href="#">Whole Class Weekly Schedule</a>	This document and template assists in planning whole-class instruction for a week in one subject.
